Our Vision

Our vision is to contribute to the power of change in these societies through targeted educational fundraising in Australia.

Why East Timor?

- East Timor (Timor-Leste) was an ally of Australia losing 40,000 of its people in WW2, fighting with the diggers against the Japanese
- Located only 600 km from Australia's coastline, approximately 46% of East Timor's population have ever had any schooling
- The illiteracy levels are approximately 60% women and 44% men
- The population is just over 1,000,000 people with over 50% under 21 years old
- International experience shows that improving levels of education in emerging societies drives economic prosperity
- East Timor is not presently equipped to educate its young children to international standards

Our track record over the last 10 years is worth noting, 277 women and 10 men have received scholarships to study at the ICFP Baucau Teachers College, and more than 665 have graduated with a Bachelor of Teaching degree, 68 with a Bachelor of Education, and 18 Masters of Education degrees. They are working in the education system and taking their knowledge back to their villages. Graduate teachers take their skills back to their home towns, rippling the effects of education and change through every level of their country.
